WASHINGTON, July 28, 1918.

Gen. Solomon, in a letter to the Commission  
of Indian Affairs, urges the speedy re-  
lease of the wandering bands of Indians in  
the northern and central portions of that  
State. He says: I am not fortunate in  
knowing the exact number of these wandering  
bands, but they are estimated to number  
about 15,000 in the northern and central  
portions of that State. They are a  
constant menace to the peace and  
prosperity of the region.
