COMMERCIAL RECORD. PITTSBURGH BOARD OF TRADE. OFFICE PITTSBURGH, June 14, 1914. The weather, being clear and warm, with a light breeze from the west, and a few clouds in the afternoon, was very pleasant. The river was at a normal stage, and the water was clear and fresh. The grain market was active, with wheat and corn prices steady. The stock market was also active, with various shares trading at different prices.

STEAMBOATS. PORT PITTSBURGH. The following steamboats are scheduled to depart from Pittsburgh: The 'Pittsburgh' to New York, leaving at 10:00 AM; the 'Allegheny' to Philadelphia, leaving at 11:00 AM; the 'Monongahela' to Baltimore, leaving at 12:00 PM.
