It is also containing a small amount of metalic iron, therefore will not corrode or erode a color, and although it writes on a color, it is a few moments after it becomes a deep black and endures for ages. It is also applied to paper, known by the name of "Abrasives," writing on one-third more given for the same sum, and at a much less expense of my kind being appreciated.
