Philadelphia, Nov. 9, 1848.

The Ocean Steamer ship arrived at New York last night at 12 o'clock, bringing news of late interest.

She sailed on the 23rd, making the trip in ten days.

### IRELAND.

O'Brien, Douglas, Hughes, and McManus have been arrested for life. Dublin's fate has been settled by the jury.

The country is in a most deplorable condition, in consequence of the failure of the potato crops, and the meagreness of the grain crops, and the want of employment.

### FRANCE.

Cervignac's new cabinet has sustained a defeat upon an amendment to the Constitution relating to the army, by a majority of twenty votes.

The discussion on the Constitution has terminated.

The contents of the President's will have been and vigorous, and the ultra Democrats are anxious for unity among themselves.

Ballots are being counted, and the results will be known in a few days.

### SPAIN.

The crisis has passed, by the return of Narvaez to power, and the establishment of a King and Queen at the head of the monarchy.

### PRUSSIA.

Final discussions took place in Berlin, on the 10th, which were renewed on the 18th, with considerable loss of life. The people gathered outside the barracks.

The cause of this outbreak was occasioned by the attempt of some mechanics to break up the machinery of the King.

### AUSTRIA.

The Commandant of the National Guard, issued a placard on the 8th, announcing that the Hungarians under Orszag and Moricz had crossed the frontier, and were to fight against the Hungarians.

The placard stated that there would be a sanguinary conflict near Vienna, and that the commandant, on that account, had posted a strong force near the Belvidere.

The advancing Hungarian army is at all times, except the Munkacsy line. The Russian Ambassador left the city, but nearly all the population refused to yield to the last, come what would.

Thousands of persons have left Vienna since the 6th.

Illichak is now at his old post, and his troops are now united with those of General Armata.

Vienna was completely captured, and it was rumored that the advancing Hungarian army had retreated in consequence of the desertion of two regiments of Hungarian Hussars to Windgrat.

Who is rumored to have been captured by the Hungarians, and taken to the city of Pest.

Provisions were scarce. The citizens of Vienna continued to strengthen their defenses, and the country people flock into the city in great numbers.

No agreement was reached between the Hungarians and the Austrian Government.
