At an arrival at this port, we have late and important intelligence from South America, with dates to September. The exciting and troublesome questions with Buenos Ayres still remain unsettled. Commerce to Buenos Ayres is again paralyzed.

Equador is already on the civil war. A combination had been discovered between certain officers and druids in New Grenada and Peru, to unite and divide Equador, and revolutionize the whole country. This design, however, was partially frustrated by the Peruvian Government, while the Grenadian allies under Guerrero, entered the northern frontier, but were vanquished.

Bolivia is a very precarious situation, on account of a disputed boundary with Peru. The object is at present vacillating, while all eyes are directed to Santa Cruz as the first man to occupy the executive chair.
