WATERFORD, Feb. 19, 1849.
SENATE.—Mr. King presented a memorial praying to carry the mail and military stores across the Isthmus of Panama, for \$12,000 a year.

Mr. Yule presented a series of resolutions on the subject of Slavery in the state of Florida.

He made a warm oration, to which Mr. Weston responded in a speech of considerable eloquence.

The General Appropriation Bill was then taken up and discussed until the hour of adjournment.
