Another Outrage by Negroes—Two White Men Killed—The Negroes Captured and Hung.

Augusta, September 11.—On Wednesday night a most horrible murder was perpetrated at Jefferson, in Columbia county, not a great distance from this place. A negro fiend deliberately split open the heads of two white men with an axe, for no provocation whatever. After the deed he attempted to escape, but was pursued and captured by the citizens and taken to a limb of a tree until dead. His body was left dangling in the air. Great excitement at the time prevailed.

MEXICO. The Puebla Rebellion Suppressed—Punishment of Conspirators.

New York, September 11.—Advice from Mexico City to the 6th inst, says: The Puebla rebellion has been put down, and Lucas and Botilla, who surrendered at discretion, were condemned to death. The rebels at Telala and San Miguel have also been defeated; Negret, Prioto and Deminguez escaped.

Ortega has issued a manifesto renouncing all claims to the Presidency. The conspirators against Jaurez have been punished.

A Florida correspondent of a Northern paper says: I think the Northern tax payers, who make their living by honest toil, should know that for two months the Government has been distributing free rations to the negroes in this State. In Leon county, where the negroes register about 2,700 votes, some 35,000 rations were issued last month alone. Do you give free rations to the laborers of the North?

National Democratic Platform.

- 1st. Immediate restoration of all the States to their rights in the Union under the Constitution, and of civil government to the American people. 2nd. Amnesty for all past political offenses, and the regulation of the elective franchise in the States by their citizens. 3rd. Payment of the public debt of the United States as rapidly as practicable; all moneys drawn from the people by taxation, except so much as is requisite for the necessities of the government, economically administered, being honestly applied to the payment, and where the obligations of the government do not expressly state upon their face, or the law under which they were issued does not provide that they shall be paid in coin, they ought in right and justice, to be paid in the lawful money of the United States. 4th. Equal taxation of every species of property according to its real value, including the government bonds, and other public securities. 5th. One currency for the government and the people, the laborer and the office-holder, the pensioner and the soldier, the producer and the bondholder. 6th. Economy in the administration of the government; the reduction of the standing army and navy; the abolition of the Freedmen's Bureau; and all political instrumentalities designed to secure negro supremacy; simplification of the system, and discontinuance of ineffectual assessing and collecting internal revenue, so that the burden of taxation may be equalized and lessened, the credit of the Government and the currency made good; the repeal of all enactments for arming the state militia into national forces in time of peace, and a tariff for revenue upon foreign imports, and such equal taxation under the internal revenue laws as will afford incidental protection to domestic manufactures, and will, without impairing the revenue, impose the least burden upon and best promote and encourage the great industrial interests of the country. 7th. Reform of abuses in the administration, the expulsion of corrupt men from office, the restoration of rightful authority, and the independence of the executive and judicial departments of the government; the subordination of the military to the civil power, to the end that the usurpations of Congress and the despotism of the sword may cease. 8th. Equal rights and protection for naturalized and native-born citizens at home and abroad; the assertion of American nationality which shall command the respect of foreign powers and furnish an example and encouragement to people struggling for national integrity, constitutional liberty and individual rights; and the maintenance of the rights of naturalized citizens against the absolute doctrine of immutable allegiance, and the claims of foreign powers to punish them for alleged crimes committed beyond their jurisdiction. 9th. Demanding that measures and reforms we arranged the Radical party for the regard of right, and the unparalleled oppression and tyranny which have marked its career. 10th. For the next session and unanimous passage of both houses of Congress to prosecute the war exclusively for the maten-

ance of the government and the preservation of the Union under the Constitution. It has repeatedly violated that most sacred pledge under which alone was rallied that noble volunteer army which carried our flag to victory. Instead of restoring the Union, it has so far as in its power, dissolved it, and set on foot a system of profound peace, to military despotism and negro supremacy. It has nullified the right of trial by jury; it has abolished the habeas corpus—the most sacred writ of liberty; it has overthrown the freedom of speech and the press; it has substituted arbitrary seizures, arrests, and military trials, and secret star chamber inquisitions for the constitutional tribunals; it has disregarded in time of peace the right of the people to be free from searches and seizures; it has entered the post and telegraph offices, and even the private rooms of individuals, and seized their private papers and letters without any specific charge or notice of affidavit, as required by the organic law; it has converted the American Capitol into a battle field, it has established a system of spies and official espionage to which no constitutional monarchy of Europe would dare resort; it has abolished the right of appeal on important constitutional questions to the supreme judicial tribunals, and threatens to curtail or destroy its original jurisdiction which is irrevocably vested by the Constitution, while the learned Chief Justice has been subjected to the most atrocious calumnies, merely because he would not prostitute his high office to the support of the false and partisan charges preferred against the President. Its corruption and extravagance have exceeded anything known in history, and by its frauds and monopolies it has nearly doubled the burden of the debt created by the war. It has stripped the President of his constitutional power of appointment, even of his own cabinet. Under its repeated assaults the pillars of the government are rocking on their base, and should it succeed in November next and inaugurate its President, we will meet as subjected and conquered people amid the ruins of liberty and the scattered fragments of the Constitution; and we do declare and resolve that ever since the people of the United States threw off all subjection to the British crown their privilege and trust of suffrage have belonged to the several states, and have been granted, regulated and controlled exclusively by the political power of each state respectively, and that any attempt by Congress, on any pretext whatever, to deprive any state of this right, or interfere with its exercise, is a flagrant usurpation of power, which can find no warrant in the Constitution, and if sanctioned by the people, will subvert our form of government, and can only end in a single centralized and consolidated government, in which the separate existence of the states will be entirely absorbed, and an unqualified despotism be established in place of a Federal Union of co-equal states; and that we regard the reconstruction acts (so-called) of Congress, as such, as usurpation, and unconstitutional, revolutionary and void. That our soldiers and sailors, who carried the flag of our country to victory against a most gallant and determined foe, must ever be gratefully remembered, and all the guarantees given in their favor must be faithfully carried into execution.
