A letter has been received at the
Treasury Department from the collector
of customs in San Francisco, giving
an account of the methods adopted by

Chinamen to smuggle opium into this
country. Every crack and crevice of

The bill to enforce the Fifteenth Amendment,

reported in Congress, the other day,
provides as follows:
All citizens of the United States, who are

qualified by law to vote at any election by
the people, shall be entitled to vote at all
elections without distinction of race, color,

or previous condition of servitude, any law
of any State, to the contrary notwithstanding.
Also, that if the laws of any State or

Territory shall require any act to be done
as a pre-requisite to voting, it shall be the
duty of the officers of the law to give equal

opportunity to all citizens of the United
States to perform such pre-requisite; and
any such official failing so to do shall forfeit

\$500 to the person aggrieved, to be recovered
at law, and in case of conviction shall
also be fined not less than \$500 and imprisoned

for one month to one year. The same
penalties are prescribed against any person
who shall hinder any citizen from performing

such pre-requisite. Person deprived of any
office except that of a member of Congress
or State Legislature by reason of violation
of the foregoing provisions may receive

possession through United States Courts
which are given concurrent jurisdiction
in all such cases. The United States District
Courts shall have exclusively of the State

Courts cognizance of crimes and offenses
against the provisions of this act. All the
officers of the United States Courts are
required, under a penalty of \$1,000, to
institute and enforce proceedings thereunder,
