Agricultural College, August 1st, 1870. To the Editor of the Reporter:—To impart additional interest to the Harvest Home instituted last year, it was thought best this year to afford manufacturers and agents an opportunity of testing the relative merits of their mowing and reaping machines.

The trial of mowers was witnessed by four or five hundred, and of reapers by fifteen hundred or two thousand of the citizens of the state, most of whom seemed much interested.
