Sept. 13, 1861. The President has received information from the Secretary of War that the Federal Government has received a report from a confidential source that the Confederates are preparing to launch a large-scale offensive against the Union. The report suggests that the Confederates are gathering troops and supplies in the South and are planning to move northward. The President is taking immediate steps to strengthen the Union's defenses and is calling for additional volunteers to the army.
