**Foreign Passports—Italy and**  
Washington, Nov. 25.—John B.  
Giddings, General Consul for the British  
North American Provinces, has accom-  
panied the object of his visit to Wash-  
ington, namely, the removal of the delay  
and inconveniences attending the granting  
of passports to British subjects taking passage  
for Europe at Portland, Maine. Here-  
tofore the passport was required to be  
contaminated by the State Department, but  
that business is now performed by a govern-  
ment agent at Portland, Maine.  
The government of Italy has adopted  
the stringent rule of France in regard to  
traveling passports, and the British North  
American Provinces, which is a great  
inconvenience to the American traveler.
