THE ARMY ALLOTMENT SYSTEM.
A general order from the War Department defines the regulations of the new allotment system in the army, as follows:—
First. The assignment of pay will be made on a separate roll, to be executed under the supervision of the captain or immediate commander of the regiment, at the time of the enlistment of the soldier in camp. Second. When completed, the allotment roll is to be transmitted to the Adjutant-General, by whom the deductions will be made on each subsequent pay roll, and the aggregate amount of such deductions is to be paid to the soldier in full, together with a copy of said roll.
