WASHINGTON, Feb. 14. A special messenger arrived this morning bringing the following dispatches:
Hon. Sec. of War, Philadelphia, Pa.
I have in your hands the report of the military authorities at Fort Mifflin, Pa., dated Feb. 13, 1862. The report states that the garrison of the fort consisted of 1,200 men, and that they were well supplied with provisions and ammunition. The fort was attacked by the enemy on the 13th inst., and after a gallant defense of several hours, it was compelled to surrender. The garrison was then marched to Lancaster, Pa., and from thence to Harrisburg, Pa., where they were quartered. The report also states that the fort was in a very good state of defense, and that the garrison was well trained and equipped.
