DAILY POST

Monday Morning, May 19. The Sun of Annapolis. On the 2d of December, 1861, rose the Sun of Annapolis. It is light revealed to Napoleon the certainty of the great victory of the day.

The allied Prussian and Austrian army, 95,000 strong, had held twenty-four hours previous position equally as strong, on the heights of Pratzen; but by a skillful manoeuvre he had induced them to believe that he feared a battle; and accordingly, on the break of day, he beheld their immense army, like a huge host, having unrolled the coil, trailing its slow, ponderous length around his front, in order to attack his right wing.

The whole length of their line was exposed; Napoleon, from his eminence, could strike the spokes of his power to attack them in any and all quarters. His Generals were eager to begin. "Wait twenty minutes," said Napoleon, "before you precipitate action. "When the enemy is making a false move they must not be interrupted by the great victory of the day."
