GUERRILLA WARFARE IN FLORIDA.
The Savannah Republican, of the 24th, says:
"We learn from a gentleman just arrived from Florida, that on Monday two of our enemy's gunboats visited Palatka, and landed about fifty men, who remained some five hours. They then withdrew and went in the direction of Avdala, in search of some naval stores, belonging to a man named Hunter. The naval stores, however, had been previously destroyed. When within fifteen miles of the latter place, Capt. Stevens' company of cavalry, who were in ambush awaiting their arrival, attacked them, killing twelve of their number, and a heavy retreat, coming down the river to Orange Mill, where they obtained lumber, and, after making camp, they lurched their dead at Madison Point, below the Mill. J. W. Bryant, formerly a lawyer of Jacksonville, and subsequently Military Governor of Florida, was on board one of the gunboats. They are now lying below Jacksonville. General Benham is compelling men, women, and children seven years of age, in St. Augustine, to take the oath of allegiance to the United States. On Tuesday a large with twenty-one Federal was discovered coming up Crook's river towards Tallahassee. When near St. Marks it was fired upon by an ambush of patriots, and seventeen of the number killed. The boat was then pulled to the opposite shore, and the remaining four jumped ashore, when a gunboat approached, shelling as she came, but doing no damage."

In these sentiments of gratitude, and though I took no part in the proceedings of the meeting recently held in Dublin, at the result of which I allude, I can assure you that there is not Ireland an individual who enters into the proceedings of the meeting with a less feeling, and a more sincere one, than that which I feel, and which I desire to see the happiness of our transatlantic friends."
