The Requisites for Peace. From the Richmond Examiner, September 20th. There are two essential requisites for peace: first, that we shall have an army in the enemy's territory strong enough to conquer it; second, that we shall have a fleet of reserve in the field as large as the army we shall employ.

At the law which we have issued in order 'putting a stop to civilians hanging their own will and pleasure.' It is a law which we have passed, and we have seen it enforced with the most rigid stringency.

We are representing the time for the decision that Europe would interfere to put an end to the war, and are now going to sleep in the belief that the war will be whipped, tired, and will finish in the north. There could not be a more fatal mistake than this of supposing peace to be near at hand.
