These rules are all dwing for the wild speculation in wool, which has got poits up to \$3, 5009\$4,25 each. It certainly is not because Mut-ton is high, for that sells regularly at lower prices per pound than live Sheep. Several of the 'ling's wholesale butchers this week have not been contonted to await the regul-ar arrival of droves, but have risited Albanx and Philadelphia to buy stock, and we suppose that nearly 1,009 head will go direct to the slaughter-houses without being included in our receipts at
