She had about three hundred tons army supplies and was taking freight at Co-lumbus yesterday morning. She is ordered below for the Yasoo Pass fleet. The Champion brings news of 6,000 bales of cot-ton, discovered in "American Bottom." Also of a new canal proposed to the Sunflower, thence down to its mouth, below Yazoo City, via Lako Washington, Deer River and Eagle Bend. All was quiet at the fleet; no further news from the Yazoo Expedition.
