GUERRILLA OUTRAGES. It having been reported to Major General Thomas that a wagon, which had become detached from a foraging train belonging to his army at Chattanooga, was attacked by a party of guerrillas, and three of the men captured, mounted and thrown into the river, he has ordered that the property of all rebel citizens living within a circuit of ten miles of the place where the men were captured, be assessed, each in his due proportion, according to his wealth, to make up the sum of thirty thousand dollars, to be divided among the families who were dependent upon the captured men for support, as follows:
