NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT
ON MONDAY, THE 24th DAY OF OC.
TUBER, 1864, the Holliday's Cove Rail Road
Company will, under, the authority of its char
ter from the Legislature of Virginia, and under
the Act of Congress declaring the Railway
Bridge at Stetchenville a lawful structure, commence the elevation of the channel span of said

belonging thereto, so as not to interfere with the
elevation construction and use of said Bridge."

necessary to its e rection removed.

the requisitions of the Act of Congress have
been complied with, by the company.
The erection of the obsannel span will be proceeded with as :rapidly as possible, and due
notice will be given as to the time when the
obstructions will be removed.
