Important, if true.—The following is from Thompson's Bank N. Y. Reporter of New York. We can scarcely believe it well founded.

It has been known to us for months past, that the heavy holders of discredited State stocks were corresponding with each other, and collecting the opinions of the ablest lawyers in this country, with a view to instituting suits against the State and against individual citizens on dishonored State bonds.

Such encouragement has been given, that an agent was despatched to Europe by the late Secretary, to solicit the co-operation of English, French, and Dutch bondholders.

It is in contemplation to institute two suits before the proper tribunals—one against a non-paying State, and another against a citizen of a non-paying State.

By some it is contended that every citizen of a State is liable for judgment against a State, and that States are corporations, emanating from the federal compact, and liable to be sued.

Others counsel a shorter course, and contend that every citizen of a State is a party to the contract between the State and the bondholders, and is liable, individually, on every bond the State rightfully owes.

The most eminent counsel have been retained for the prosecution; and all that talent and money can do, will be done.
