

The Vigilant.
A Row—Attempt to take the Engine and Reel from the House—False Alarm.
Yesterday in the forenoon, Fourth street was the scene of a regular row, caused by the attempt on the part of the "new organization" to gain possession of the Vigilant Engine and apparatus. The Mayor having refused to obey the resolution of Councils instructing him to give the Engine to the new company, Messrs Morgan, M'Elroy and others, went to the house, broke the lock, brought out the Engine and Reel, and attempted to take them away. One of the members of the company now in possession, immediately seized the bell rope and sounded the alarm, which was understood by the others, who in a short time were on the ground "wager for the fray." Now came the tug of war—the "new organization" had hold of the ropes of the Engine and Reel, and the "old organization" had hold of tongues, wheels, &c. A desperate struggle ensued. Some one cut the ropes of both Engine and Reel, which laid the "new organization" sprawling in a mess on the street. Thus the other party triumphed. They replaced what they are pleased to call "their property" in the house, which they fastened up with bolts, bars and spikes.

The person who raised the alarm was brought before the Mayor, but no one appearing against him, he went his way. We understand, however, that he was afterwards prosecuted before an Alderman.

The members in possession, we are told, have commenced suit against the persons who broke the lock, before Ald. Stewart of the Fifth ward. Why they should go to Raywardston for "justice" when there is so much to be had in our own town, we cannot tell.

The Vigilant question is of but little importance to the citizens generally, but it has been managed so as to create considerable excitement since its first breaking out. The affairs of the engine have been in a state of confusion ever since that time was discovered. In one of the "organizations" may be spoken by a legal decision, before peace can be restored.
