Cut a piece of cloth or leather a little larger than the cancer and spread a thin coat and apply it: it will give much pain. Take epsom salts for the blood every d.y, but not enough to physic. It may take a week before it is all out; when you suppose it is all out, then to cleanse it, take garget root, (some call it cocum) pound and strain as above, and try it on a plate.--Apply plasters of it daily until healed up.
