SENTECE OF DEATH.—Judge Paton yesterday sentenced Charles Deibel to imprisonment for twelve years in the Penitentiary, for the murder of his wife on the 1st day of April last. In passing the sentence Judge P. remarked that he entertained a very high respect for the decision of the jury, but thought that, in this case, Diabelli had exceeded the punishment merited.

RECORDS OF NATURAL MAGIC.—Mr. Vincent was brought up on a charge of violating the city ordinance in relation to records.
