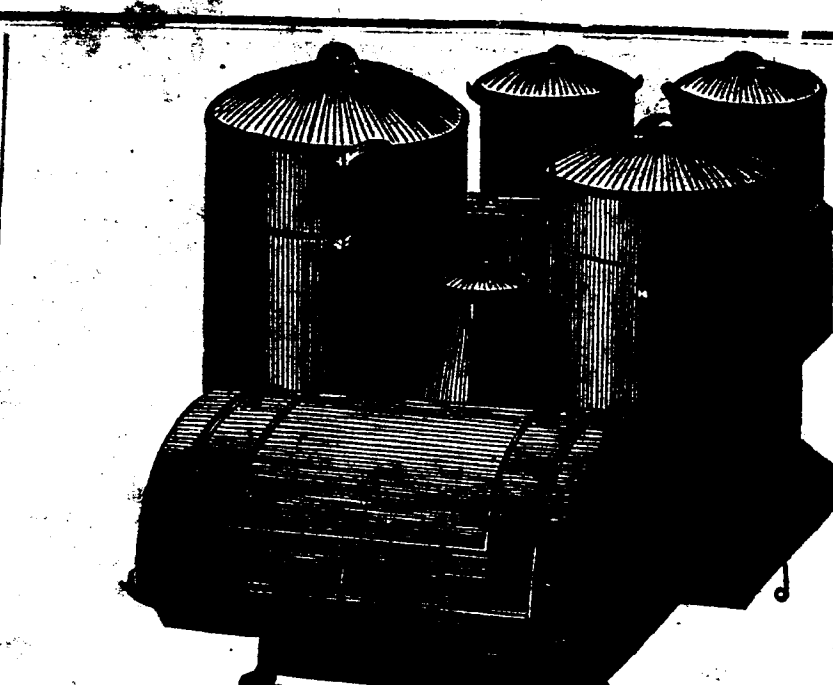


Illustration of a large industrial machine, possibly a steam engine or boiler, with various pipes and components.
