From the N. O. Picayune, April 29. LATEST FROM MEXICO.

By the arrival at this port yesterday of the schooner Yucateco, Frats, master, from Vera Cruz—whence she sailed on the 21st inst.—we have advices nine days later than we had previously received.

When the Schooner sailed, there were four U. S. vessels of war lying there, when the Yucateco left.

The report which we had previously received of the earthquake which took place in Mexico on the 10th inst., are fully confirmed.

Many houses were utterly destroyed, and a still larger number much injured.

The earthquake would seem to have extended across the country.

Excursions and other points it was felt, though at different dates, and in some of the Departments the shocks occurred on several successive days.

The newspapers were occupied as usual with the discussion of the measure of annexation.
