Resolved, Therefore, That, understanding these views, the Democratic party of this Union, through their delegates assembled in a general Convention, conformed to a spirit of cordiality in the election and choice of a free representative government, and according to their duties to the people, they have elected to the office of President and Vice President, and to the office of members of the American people the following gentlemen, who were elected by the people of the United States, and who are hereby proclaimed as the candidates for President and Vice President of the United States.
