Police Officer Severcly Stabbed --- Important Arrests.

it will be remembered that on last Monday evening a man named Jacob Voelker was attacked by two men at the end of the Railroad Bridge in Allegheny and badly beaten, hav ing been struck with a hatchet or adze on the head, inflicting severe wounds. The perpetrators of the outrage were unknown. On Thursday atternoon, Mayor Weaver visited Voetker at his house in Birmingham, and took his affidavit, preferring a charge of assault and battery with intent to kill a ainst two unknown p rsons, of whom he could give but a meagre description. The description was given to officers Rague and Moon, who searched for the perpetrators and on yesterday afternoon, on the corner of Seventh and Smithfield they saw and arrested a young man named William Moorhead, whom they believed to be the principal in this affair. On the way to the Mayor's office, Moorhead

stopped at the corner of Virgin alley and Smithteld street to get a drink, the officers accompanying him. After drinking te started to the door, ran out and closed tha door bo hund him. The officers gave chase and he was soon captured. I'n arriving at the office Mcorhead stoutly denied the charge,

but the brother of Voelker, who was with him at the time of the assault, being sent for, he identified him as one of the parties who committed the outrage. He was locked up for a hearing at ten o'clock this morning. Moerhead is a young

While three of them were searching for him in the upper part of the mansion, officer Andrew Moon proceeded to the cellar, and coming upon young Grier unawares in the dark, he received a severe stab at his hand in a lower part of the abdomen. The weapon used was a angle proket knife, with a blade about four inches in length,

. i.e. Ma in received the stab from the young desperado A before he knew that he was near him. He was taken to the leaf store of Morgan & Co., on Wood street, near Sixth, where his wound was examined and temporarily dressed by Dr. Watter, after which he was conveyed to his residence in a baggy.

. Walter says the wound is a severe one, and is so located that danger may result, but expresses the opinion that as the knife pointed downward, and the wound was made so low down on the body, that the cut is not of such a character as to cause any immediate apprehension, and with care to prevent infla-umation, may not result seriously. Both for the sake of the very worthy officer who has thus suffered in nischarging his dut , and the misguided young man who made the deadly assault, we hope the injury may yield to the skill of the physician. Young Grier has, by his evil

courses, given much pain to a large circle of most respectable frends and relatives, who have tried every means in their power to reform him. He has been in the House of Refuge, but was released, as was hoped, a reformed man, but now a more serious evil has befallen him. He is under arrest, and will be detained in prizon until the result of officer Moon's wound is ascertained, and will also be held to answer for the outrageous assault on Voelker, who is represented as being


