EDUCATIONAL.

Supplement to the Common School Law—1854. A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT to an Act for the regulation and continuance of a System of Education by Common Schools, approved the 8th day of May, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four.

fourth sections of the act to which this is a supplement, and the proper court of quarter sessions shall moreover determine, on hearing, whether an undue proportion of the real estate and school houses belonging to the old district or districts are within the bounds of the new district, and if so, how much money shall be paid therefor by the new to the old district or districts, and in what proportions and at what time; and if less than its share of real estate or school houses is within said new district, how much shall be paid to it by the old district, or districts, and in what proportions and at what times; the order for the payment of which several sums shall, from the date thereof, be in the nature of a judgment, and the amount recoverable according to the provisions of the twenty-first section of the act to which this is a supplement.
