AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO DOGS &c.—Section 1st. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Clearfield and is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that it shall be the duty of the High Constable within two weeks of the first Monday of May in each and every year hereafter, to make or cause to be made a list of all the dogs and bitches within the limits of the borough to return the same to the Burgess on or before the first Monday of May, which said list shall contain a short description of said dogs and bitches, the name of the owner or owners thereof, and in case no owner can be found the name of the person or persons about whose house or premises the said dogs or bitches may be harbored; for which service the High Constable shall receive ten cents for each dog or bitch so returned, to be paid by order on the borough Treasurer.
