A good deal of surprise has been felt, and pretty freely expressed, too, of course, at the unexpected number of rejections of drafted men, for the manifoldly-maimed causes comprehended under the general head of "physical disability." The interesting fact has, however, been established at the Surgical Bureau in Washington, that the proportion of our people who are exempted from the draft on account of disibility from physibility causes is scarcely greater than in England or France. In the latter countries the average per centage is a shade less than twenty five per cent., while with us it does not in practice exceed thirty. Here the majority of our surgeons are volunteers, and they release persons for disabilities that experienced surgeons in the regular army would not. The latter are supposed to be better able to judge what forms of weakness in constitution or health would be bettered by camp-life. Again it is held, that as the volunteering of a million of men took the flower of population, it might reasonably be expected that a large proportion of the conscripts would be exempted for disability.

----A Chattanooga correspondent, writing on the 3d, says: "A rebel deserter came in yesterday, and reports that our dead are still unburied on the battle-field of Chickamauga. He was one of those appointed to gather up the arms, balls, clothes, and other debris of the fight, but was compelled to abandon the work on account of the unbearable stench arising from the decomposing bodies of our fallen brothers and sons. He saw several lying where the wagons hourly passed over them."

A Few days since, a lot of negroes collected at the Richmond gas-works for religious purposes. They were captured by the police who took forty-three into custody, and after a hearing before Judge Chandler, each man received ten lashes. This item may be commended to the attention of Bishop Hopkins, the apologist of slavery.

Surgeon-General Hammond has been ordered ot Nashville, Tennessee, on a tour of inspection among the hospitals of our western armies. According to official reports there are \$4,472 beds for patients in the United States general hospitals, and there are at present 40,195 persons under treatment.


