POISONOUS POTATOES.—The sprouts of the potato contain an alkaloid, termed by chemists solanine, which is very poisonous if taken into the system. This does not exist in the tubers, unless they are exposed to the light and air, which sometimes occurs from the accidental removal of the earth in cultivation.

TO REMOVE "PROUD FLESH."—Pulverize loaf sugar very fine, and apply it to the part affected. This is a new and easy remedy, and is said to remove it entirely, without pain. It has been practiced in England for years.
