OBITUARY.—FRANK G. IRWIN was born in Bellefonte, Centre Co., Pa., September 14, 1852. He was wounded at 9 o'clock a. m. March 31st, and died just 36 hours after. They then advanced to him, about eight in number, stripped him, kicked and trampled on him, then fired three arrows into his body, two in his chest and one in his left arm, and then started after some other victims, two of whom they met and served in like manner. Frank then walking about half a mile to town, when he was seen by Mr. Ward who carried him into town. The bullet and arrows were carefully and skillfully extracted by Dr. Harrison, and all that love and humanity could do to relieve his intense suffering was lavishly bestowed as you may suppose.
