PROCLAMATION.—GENERAL ELECTION.—Whereas, in and by the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, entitled, "An Act relating to the Elections of the Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania," it is made the duty of the Governor to give public notice of the General Election, and in such notice to enumerate— 1st.—The Officers to be elected. 2d.—The Districts and the places at which the election is to be held.
