The undersigned, having resigned his position as Paymaster in the U. S. Army, has opened at No. 204 SOUTH FOURTH STREET, an AGENCY FOR PROCURING PENSIONS, and for the collection of Officers', Soldiers', and other CLAIMS against the Government.

My long experience as Paymaster, has given me unusual facilities for becoming thoroughly acquainted with this business, and all its details. On the receipt, by mail, of a statement of the case of claimants, I will forward the necessary papers for their signature. Personal attention will be given to the cases at Washington.

No charge unless successful, when \$5 will be charged for collecting all sums under \$50, and \$10 on all sums over that amount and under \$200. Larger claims taken on special arrangement. Fees in Pension cases as fixed by law.

INFORMATION FOR AND INSTRUCTIONS TO CLAIMANTS. All Soldiers of the present war, who have served two years, and Soldiers discharged for wounds received in the war, without reference, are entitled to a Pension according to the disability.

In case of the death of the Soldier before discharge, through disease contracted, or wounds received while in service, his widow or his next of kin may be entitled to a Pension according to the disability.

If deceased Soldier or Seaman leaves no widow, his children are entitled to the same benefits as the widow, except when the children may be over the age of 16 years.

Discharged Soldiers, whose clothing account was settled at the time of discharge, can recover any balance due them, if the Company books are not destroyed. To draw this balance, you are required to send to me with your preliminary statement, giving also the date of your discharge, and served with the nine month volunteers, a receipt for \$20 bounty and premium, without regard to time of service, if they have not already received it.

Soldiers who were prisoners in the South, and Soldiers who were absent on duty, are entitled to computation of ratable service.

In communicating with this office, state the nature of your claim fully, and give the Company and Serjeant in which you or the Soldier for whom you claim belonged, as well as your present Post Office address.
