NASHVILLE, Dec. 2.—I have received full accounts of the battle of Franklin, which took place on Wednesday last. It was one of the most brilliant of the war.

FOR THREE DAYS sharp fighting was kept up during the retirement of our army from the River to Franklin, during which time a multitude of exploits and successes were accomplished.

Gen. Cox conducted the rear guard, and on the 26th day, achieved a splendid victory over the rebels at Spring Hill, where General Wood's cavalry gained a series of important successes.

On the 28th of November, the Rebels again moved upon our army at Franklin, where they were met by the gallant troops of our army, under the command of Gen. Schofield.
