CUTTING GRASS LATE.-My practical knowledge is not only of long standing, has been very extensive, and I am an entirely practical writer, and indulge in ne theories; from 1835 to 1856 my experience was as great as it was possible for any man's to be; during the last fourteen years of that period I was steward for a nobleman who had three large landed estates, about 100 miles apart, besides several smaller ones containing about as many hundred acres as the larger ones did thousands. One fourth at least of the whole of this landed property was in permanent grass, which had remained unbroken sward for scores of years, and some of it for hundrds of years; none of this grass land had deteriorated, but most of it was much improved, so that having the farming of many hundreds of it, and the HOSIERY, GLOVES, AND KNIT GOODS, superintendence of thou ands, rented to opulent tenants, I ought to know something of grass land; and here I might as well say that many of my remarks are meant to apply to old permanent grass land composed of natural varieties, and not to clover or timothy, which make naught but temporary grass, and will run out. But I am not to be made to believe

that it is good for the hay, when made from clover, to be turning to seed, much more have some seed quite ripe at the expense of the stems and leaves; who wants seed for cattle? Nor can any one convince me that the whole landed proprietors in England are fools, which they must be if the statement above will apply generally, for every lease in that country expresses that clover shall not be allowed to seed, excepting in small quantites, because of its exhaustive effects. Since being in this country I fed hay cut when in bloom to working oxen, horses, and some hundreds of sheep; it so happened that a late spring, and being overstocked, rendered it necessary to buy from a neighbor who cut his hay late, and the consequence was the whole of the animals had to have extra meal and grain, and then the horses lost flesh, and oxen suffered worse, and the sheep sank shillings per head, and the ewes half starved their lambs. Common sense will tell any one that hay is hay, but straw is a different article, and pray what is any stemmy substance which has matured seed, but straw?.

MEDICINAL PROPERTIES OF CELERY .-A corespondent of the Practical Farmer SWISS CURTAINS, writes: I have known many men and women too, who, from various causes had become so much affected with nervousness that when they stretched out their hands they shook like aspen leaves on windy days-and by a daily moderate use of the blanched foot stalks of celery leaves as a salad they became as strong and steady in limbs as other people.

I have known others so very nervous that the least annoyance put them in a state of agitation, and they were almost in constant perplexity and fear, who were also effectually cured by a daily moderate use of blanched celery as a salad at meal times. I have known others cured by using celery for palpitation of the heart. Everybody engaged in labor weakening to the nerves, should use celery daily in season, and onions, in its stead when not in

FINE MEAD .- Beat to a strong froth the whites of three eggs, and mix them Corn, Oats, with six gallons of water; six quarts of Middlings, Chop, strained honey, and the yellow rind of two dozen fine lemons, pared very thin. Boil all together during three quarters of an hour, skimming it well. Then put into a tub; and when lukewarm add three tablespoonfuls of the best fresh yeast. Cover it over and leave it to ferment. When it has done working transfer it to a cask, with the lemon peel in the bottom. Let it stand six hours, then bottle it
