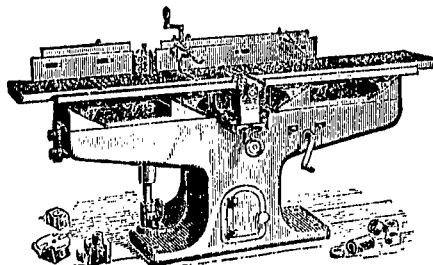


No. 2 Planer and Matcher.
