opening of each meeting, determine by roll call the nam. ber ofactive members present in order that the presence of a quorum may be decided. He shall carry on all corres. pondence not within the province of either of the Depart. mente.
Bration 4 - It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to cold lect all fees, dues, and assessments, to receive donations rnd, from the munagers, the receipts from all Athletic events, to keep a full and correct account of all money re. ceived and paid out, under fout separate heads:-Associa. tion ; Football ; Baseball ; and General Athletics. Under the hend of Association sccount shall all items not belong. ing to elther of the other accounts be entered. He shall pay out money from the Association account only upon writtenorder from the President, and from the several Deparitments accounts upon witten order from the respec. tive managers. Nor may he transfer money from one account to anothor without a two thitds vote of the Associa. tion.

Stomon $5 .-1 t$ shall be the duty of the Board of Auditors to examine the books of the 'Ireasurer whonever so direct. ed by the Association, and at the end of each term. In each case the result shall be reported to the Association.

## ARTIULE V.

Seotion 1, -All elections shall be by bullot.
Shotion 2.-All ballots must be cast in person
Stotion 3.-The candidate recetplng a majoity of all le gal votes enist shall be duolared elected.
Buotion 4.-If on the first ballot no candidate has re celved a majority of all legal voteg cast, on the secona bal. lot all except the two candiates reculving the highest number of legal votes cast, shall loe dropped.
Seorion f.-At least twice as many persons slall be nominated for caoll office as are requived to fll it.
Beotion 6, The names of all nominees must be handed to the Secretary and published by him at least one week be. fore the election.
Skotion 7. When a vacancy occurs in an office a successor shall be elceted as soon as possible.

## AKTICLE VI.

Shotion 1.-Assessments may be laid by a two-thitids vote of the active members.

## ARTIOLE VIL.

The Aesociation may on a two thirds vote of the aclive members direct the Trensurer to transfer funds from one account toanother.

## ARTICLE VIIL.

Should any officer or member of a commitiou neglect, or be found incompetent to diseliarge the duties of his oftice he may be renioved by a vote of twothiris of the active members.

ARTICLE IX.
Shomion 1.-The Football Department ehall be governed by a l3oard of Directors composed of thwe elected mem bers, Captain and Coach, members Ex.Oplcio, and the mana. her a lay member.
Srotion 2.-The Association shall, on the sbcond Monday of the winter term, elect a Manager, $u$ Marshal, and a committee of three for this Department.

Section 3.-It shall be the athty of the Manager to make
and accept all challenges and to attond to all business matters incident to the Department. He shall deposit, with. out delay, all money he may recelve belonging to the De. partment, with the Treasurer, and shall issue orders on the same for the payment of all debts contractod by tho Department.
Sterrion 4.-It shall be the cluty of the Marshal to take charge of all goods when not in use and trophies belonging to this department.

Sitorio:s 5.-The duties of tho Board of Direotors shall be to select the team, to arivise with the Captain in the plac. ing of the selected men, and to aot as an advisory commit. tee to the Manager.
Sbotion 6.-Before the Saturday following Thantsgiving day the team shall elect $a$ Captain for the next season.
Shotion 7.-The word "team," wherever used, sliall mean
the regular players and substitutes as selected by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE X,
The control of the liaseball Department shall corresponal to that of the Football Depertment, excopting the Captain for the next year shall be elected on the Saturday precetling commencemont and the Manager, Marshal ant Committee shall be elected on the first Mondity after Thanksgiving Day.

## ARTICLE XI.

The control of the General Athletio Department shall correspond to that of the Baseball Department, cacepting the Managen, Marsinal and Committee shall be elected the first Monday in October.

## ARTIULE XLI.

No person shall repiesent thes Assoolution in any athlotic contest or game, either at the College or elsewhere, unless such person bo at the time an active member.

ARTICLE XIII,
Any part of the Constitution or By laws may beamendeal or repealed by a four-fifths (4.5) vote of all active members, providing that the proposed ohange shall havo been pisb lished at least two weeks before.

## ARTICLEXIV.

This Constitution and $13 y$-laws shall go into efrect Sep tember 1st, 1895, and all offloers then gerving and fultilling the requirements shall retain office until the samo oxpiret under this Constitution and By-laws.

## BY.LAWS.

## ARTICLE 1 .

Segtion 1.-Tilis Association ahall call its mectings at, such time and such place as the Prosident may dircet.
Bicarion 2,-Whe President shall hold a meeting at the re quest of three members.
Skorion 3.-Forty per cent: of active members shall constitute a quorum.
Scorion 4,-At the opening of each meeting the President shall designate the section of seats to be occupied by active and associate members respectively.

## ARTICLE 15.

Beorion 1.- Each ective member shall be required to pav yearly dues of one dollar.
Starion 2-Said yerrly dues must be malil before October first of each year.
