The following is the action recently taken at Harvard with a view of eliminating plagiarism in college work: "The Administrative Board of Harvard College, holding that handing in by a student of written work not his own is dishonorable and unworthy of a member of this University, proposes hereafter to separate from the college a student guilty of such conduct."

The Faculty of Boston University has decided to allow work on the college papers to count as a certain number of hours' work toward graduation.

President C. K. Adams, of the University of Wisconsin, in speaking of football, says: "If you trace the antagonism to football, you will find that it is most intense where the person criticising the sport knows the least about it."

Statistics have been published showing that of the 1112 men who played football on college elevens last season, but ten were temporarily disabled and only one permanently injured.

In Germany there are thirteen law, eighteen medical and five theological students to every 100,000 inhabitants. In the United States there are seven law, twenty-four medical and eleven theological students to every 100,000.

Eighty-four courses of study are announced for the Cornell summer school. The session will open on July 8th, and will extend to August 16th.
