novel idea and is very amusing. The second of the "Snob Papers" is much to be commended, and we eagerly await the next.

Our southern sisters fall considerably below the usual standard. The April *University of Virginia Magazine* was a sore disappointment, and the *Gray Jacket* for March considerably increased this feeling. The former had one redeeming feature, its verse; but the verse of the latter was conspicuous by its absence, for which its editors deserve censure.
