BACCALAUREATE SERMON.

The Baccalaureate service held in the chapel on Sunday morning, June 10, was the opening exercise of the 40th annual commencement. The sermon was delivered by the Rev. Dr. Lawrence M. Colfelt, of Philadelphia, formerly college preacher and dean of ethics. Dr. Colfelt's subject was, "The worth of fidelity to duty," and he took as his text Luke XIX, 17: "Because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities."
