On Friday, May 31, and Saturday, June 1st, the Pan-American Intercollegiate Athletic Championships will be held on the Athletic Field of the magnificent Stadium on the grounds of the Pan-American Exposition.

The following track and field events are open to all amateur undergraduate collegians of the United States:

100 yards dash, 220 yards dash, 440 yards run, half-mile run, one mile run, two miles run, 120 yards hurdle race (10 hurdles, 3 feet 6.) 220 yards hurdle race (10 hurdles, 2 feet 6 inches.) Running high jump, running broad jump, pole vault, putting 16-lb. shot, throwing 16-lb. hammer.

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and third men respectively in each event. Trophies will be given to the two colleges scoring greatest number of points.
