for 4 yards, Partridge made 4 through center, Wray 1 and Kunkel 1 through the same place, "Mac" kicked to Kreider, who was downed on the Freshman 20 yard line.

Lilley tore through right tackle for 3 and Zinc made 1 through left. The next play was the prettiest of the game. Honhart in attempting to catch the ball for a punt, fumbled, but picked it up and circled left end for a 25 yard run, the longest of the game. Here McComb was hurt and forced to retire, Montz taking his place. The Freshmen fumbled again on the next play but Lilley picked up the ball and ran around the end for a 5 yard gain. Here the Sophs were again penalized 5 yards for offside play. Kreider made a first down through center, Ritchie failed to gain, Honhart made a 7 yard gain around right end. Van Horn was thrown for a yard loss, Kreider made 1 through center. Honhart kicked to Dimelow who ran the ball back 20 yards to the Sophs 45 yard line. Wray plunged

through center for 2. Partridge made 12 on a short end run. Henry was thrown by Lilley without gain, Wray made 1 through center. "Mac" punted to Kreider who fumbled, the ball rolling out of bounds at the 10 yard line, and Honhart falling on it. Van Horn made 2 and Lilley 1 through tackle. Honhart punted to "Mac" who made a fair catch on the 50 yard line, "Mac's" try for goal fell short, Lilley catching the ball and running it back 10 yards.

Ritchie made 8 yards through Kunkle then added 2 more through the same place. Time was then called. Line-up.
