Barrett Prizes.

The prizes of \$100, \$75 and \$50
for the three best essays on "The
Relations of the United States with
the Latin-American Republics" are
offered by Mr. Barrett, subject to
the following conditions:—

(1) The competition is open to
any student, man or woman, now
registered in a regular undergradu-
ate course in any college or univer-
sity of recognized standing in the
United States.

(2) Papers submitted by compe-
titors must not exceed 10,000 words
in length.

(3) Papers accompanied by the
full name and address of the writer,
and statement of the class and col-
lege to which the write belongs,
must be mailed or delivered to an
express company not later than
Wednesday, May 10, 1905, ad-
dressed to the President of Colum-
bia University, New York, N. Y.,
marked "For the John Barrett
Prize."
