The Appropriation.

The bill passed unanimously by the state legislature appropriating \$357,536 for the college was cut down some by Governor Pennypacker along with a great many others. He swung his axe deep into the very trunk of what should be our chief support. The following are the items vetoed: The appropriation for the new agricultural building was cut from \$150,000 as recommended by the legislature to \$75,000, the item of \$21,583 for the extension of the heating and lighting plant for the agricultural building was vetoed altogether, the item of \$7,500 for new equipments for the different engineering departments was cut to \$2,500 and that of \$3000 for repairing the boiler rooms and putting in new pipes was cut \$2000. The total reduction was \$103,583.

Thompson Elected.
