

J. K. Burton, '02, has resigned from the U. G. I., of Philadelphia, and is investigating the recovery of ammonia from various distilation industries.


Leroy F. Shaner, '04, has resigned from the General Electric Company to accept a position with the Baldwin Locomotive Works.
