"Billy" Dunn, '05, captain of State's basketball team the last two years was wearing that characteristic smile at the game last Saturday.

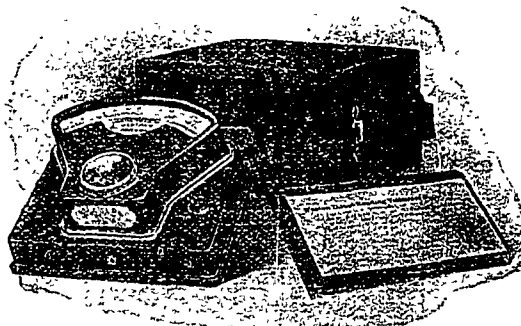
J. F. Johnson, '05, who is in the employ of the Westinghouse Company, is at his home in Bloomsburg recovering from a general break down.
