Remember the special rates, only twenty-five cents for this entertainment. Reserved seats ten cents extra. Tickets and chart now at the Co-op.

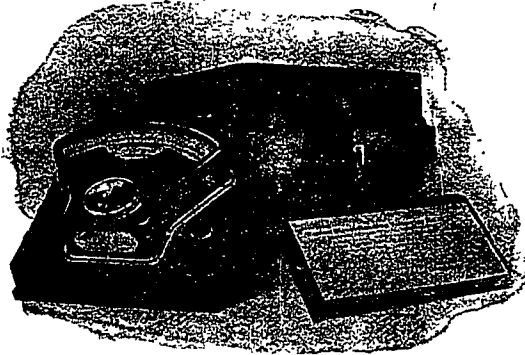
