- (3) Profane and vile language cannot be tolerated in Room 273. Those who do not care to observe this rule are requested to keep out of the room.


These rules are not drawn up with any intention to restrict the use of the room, but only to insure its *proper* use. No gentleman will want to disregard these rules.
